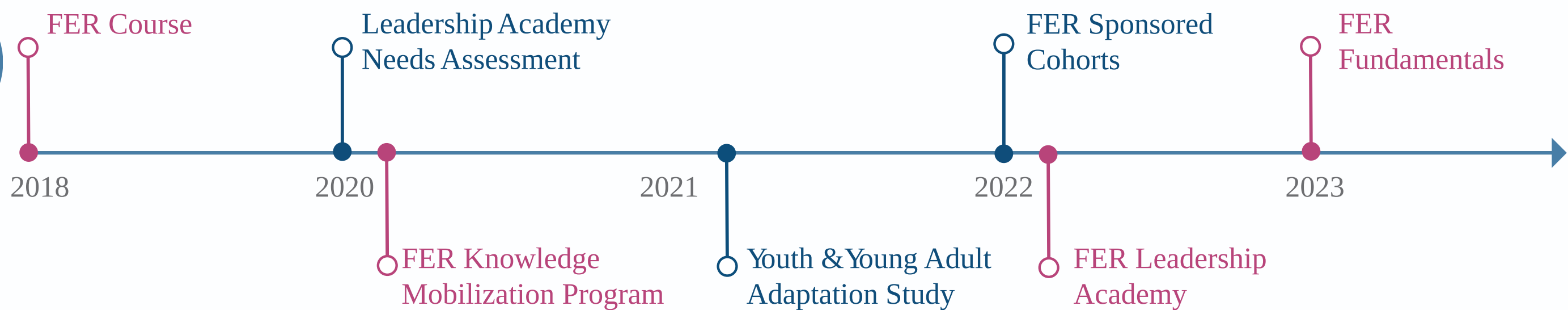


FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM

13 Trained Course Instructors

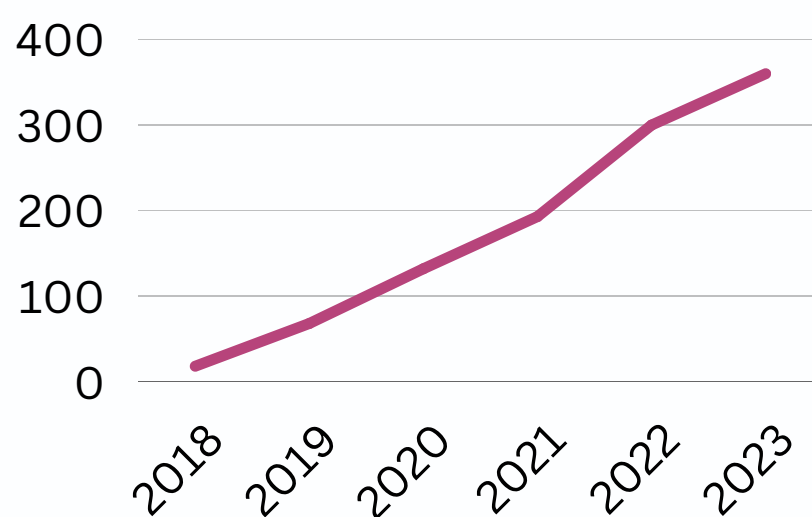
